GPS Trackdown for Android

Helpful Hints – What is ICE?

- ICE (In Case of Emergency) is a program that enables first responders, such as paramedics, firefighters, and police officers, as well as hospital personnel, to contact the next of kin of the owner of a mobile phone to obtain important medical or support information. GPS Trackdown can transmit your current location to your ICE contact. We also support the language-independent E.123 recommended ICE format (e.g. "01Anna" or "01Spouse").
- Create a new *Phone* contact with the display name ICE. (Note that the contact must be a "Phone" or "Local" contact). Ensure that you define an email address, a mobile number and optionally a work and home number.
- Let your ICE contact know that you are using GPS Trackdown and that he or she has been designated as your emergency contact. Read our Helpful Hints regarding Remote Trackdown and Panic Trackdown.
